Moon stamp. The show cancel turns the clock all the way

back to 1902, when going to the moon was nothing more

than fantasy and camera tricks. It features Georges Méliès

iconic image of a bullet-shaped rocket lodging itself in the

eye of the moon from the film “*A Trip to the Moon*.”

Please join us at the frames Saturday at 3pm to hear their insights on each of the competitive exhibits.

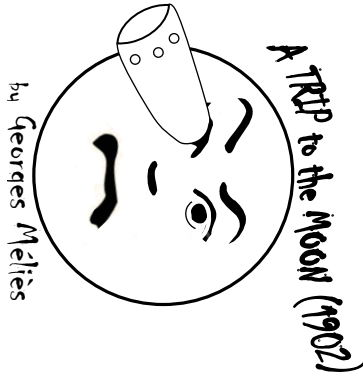

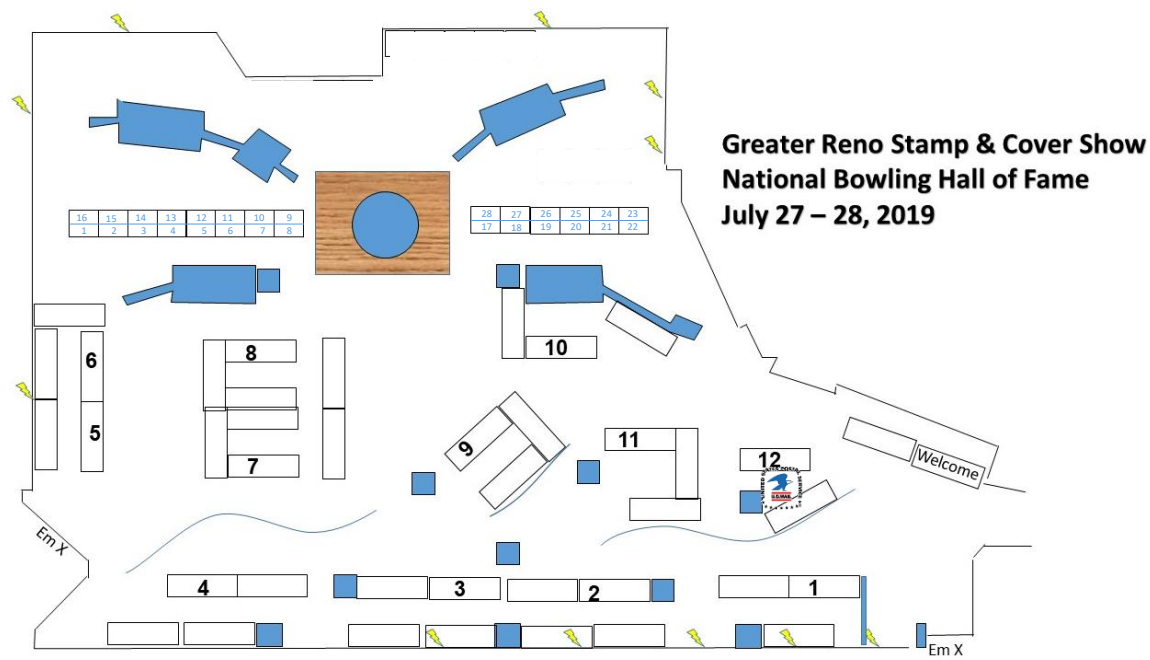

About the Show Cover

Fifty years ago, on July 16, 1969, Apollo 11 blasted off for the moon with astronauts Armstrong, Aldrin, and Collins aboard. Four days later, on July 20th, the lunar module undocked from the service module and began its decent to the moon's surface. After 21 hours and 36 minutes, Armstrong and Aldrin left the moon's surface to rejoin Collins on the service module and their return to earth.
