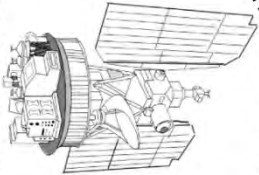

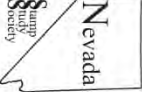

Everyone who collects, buys and or sells postage stamps or materials is invited to visit the Nevada Stamp Study Society (NSSS); we're far more casual and interactive than our name may imply. We have over 60 active members and meet on the second and fourth Saturday of every month. Meetings are currently held at the Silverada Estates Mobile Home Park Community, 2301 Oddie Blvd, Reno as well as over ZOOM. Meetings start at 10am but we encourage everyone to show up early to socialize.

The club has a members-only online auction and an in-person auction on the second Saturday of each month. On the fourth Saturday of each month, we invite a guest speaker to make a presentation related to stamp collecting.

The July 24th cover welcomes Nevada's newest museum, the Northern Nevada African American Firefighter Museum. Chief William Lobster, featured in the cachet, is the first known African American Fire Chief in Nevada.

The July 23rd cover commemorates the 50th anniversary of the launching of the Earth Resources Technology Satellite, later renamed LANDSAT 1. In 1973, a Canadian researcher analyzing LANDSAT images discovered the small island featured on the cover. The uninhabited island was 12 miles off the coast of Labrador and was officially named Landsat Island in 1979.

This year we feature LANDSAT Island in the July 23rd show cover cachet and Black Springs Fire Chief William Lobster in the July 24th cachet.

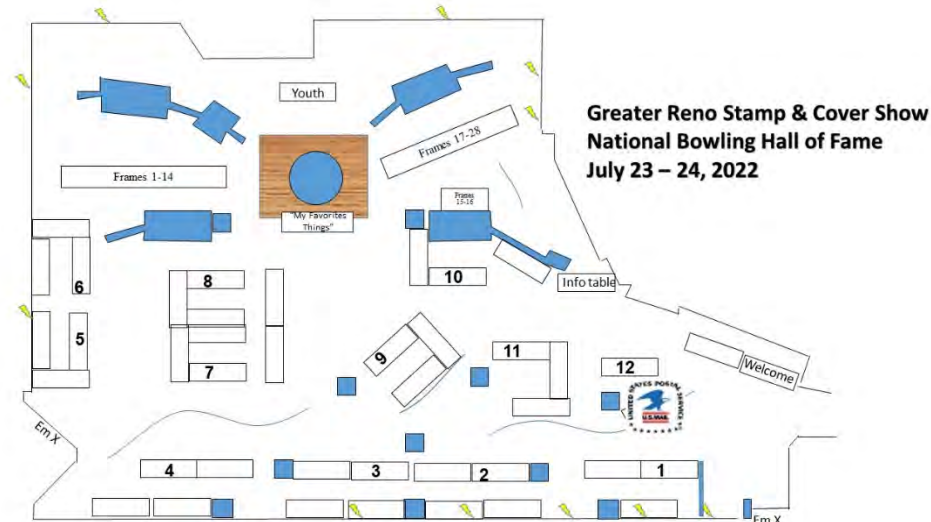

About the Show Covers

July 23rd Cover: The LANDSAT 1, a modified weather satellite, was launched 50 years ago today, opening "a new window on our planet." It was the first earth-observing satellite explicitly designed to study the planet. In 1973, a Canadian researcher analyzing LANDSAT images discovered a small uninhabited island 12 miles off the coast of Labrador that was later named Landsat Island.

July 24th Cover: Celebrate Nevada's newest museum, the Northern Nevada African American Firefighter Museum. The museum spotlights the history of Black Springs and the firefighters of the Black Springs Volunteer Fire Department under the leadership of Chief William Lobster, the first known African American Fire Chief in Nevada.
