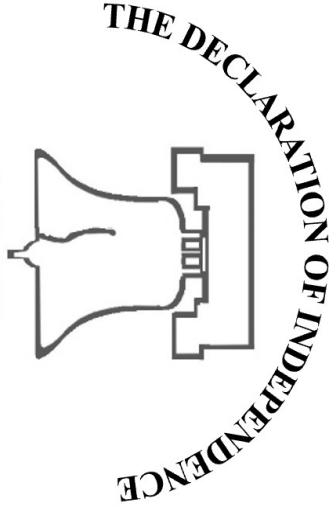

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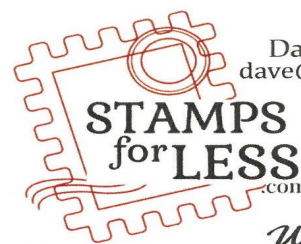

About the Show Covers

This year is the 250th anniversary of the adoption of the Declaration of Independence by the Continental Congress in 1776, marking the birth of the United States as an independent nation. In observance of America's Semiquincentennial, we are making available a different show cover for each day.

July 11th Cover: The cover features a liberty torch cancelation, a symbol of our freedom and a beacon for those who seek a better way of life. The cachet includes a snippet from Emma Lazarus's poem "The New Colossus."

July 12th Cover: The cover features a Liberty Bell cancelation. The cachet features a map of the 13 original colonies. Fun Fact: In 1776, the bell was known as the "State House Bell" and was not rung on July 4 or July 8 during the official public reading celebration. The bell tower's wood was rotting and in need of repair. The was renamed "The Liberty Bell" in the 1830s by abolitionist groups.

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
